

# Two mf

You own a 35mm DLSR camera and want to make correct images through the use of shifts and tilt/swing movements according the Scheimpflug rule. You wish to use your medium format film backs with the above-mentioned professional capabilities. Your dream would be to create the sharpest landscape images on 4x5". All this becomes a reality with the new ARCA-SWISS M-Line Two.

The M-line Two is a „redux of the camera“ for individual and customized solutions. The new M-Line Two precision camera allows you, in conjunction with a digital SLR body, to produce fantastic landscape, architecture or tabletop photography. The usable focal length range extends from 28mm up to 180mm.

The movements allow simultaneous tilt and swing adjustments as well as shifts in X and Y direction. With the ability of stitching together images, a wider image-angle can be achieved, and the resolution increases considerably. The optical bench allows a variable reproduction scale therefore making it possible to photograph both a coin as well as a landscape image with the same camera configuration. The camera is equipped with the patented ARCA-SWISS orbix® tilt arrangement, the only device with which a precise plane of sharp focus is achieved. The vast selection of camera accessories transform the M-Line Two into a 6x9 medium format or even a 4x5" camera. The M-Line Two is part of the extensive ARCA-SWISS camera system.
